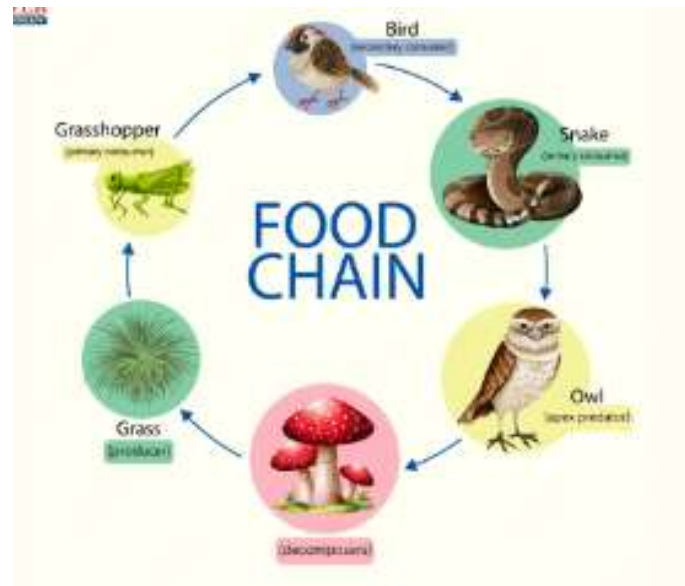

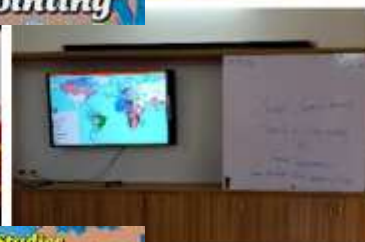

10. Delta Regions: The Ganges-Brahmaputra delta and the Kaveri delta are two significant delta regions in India.

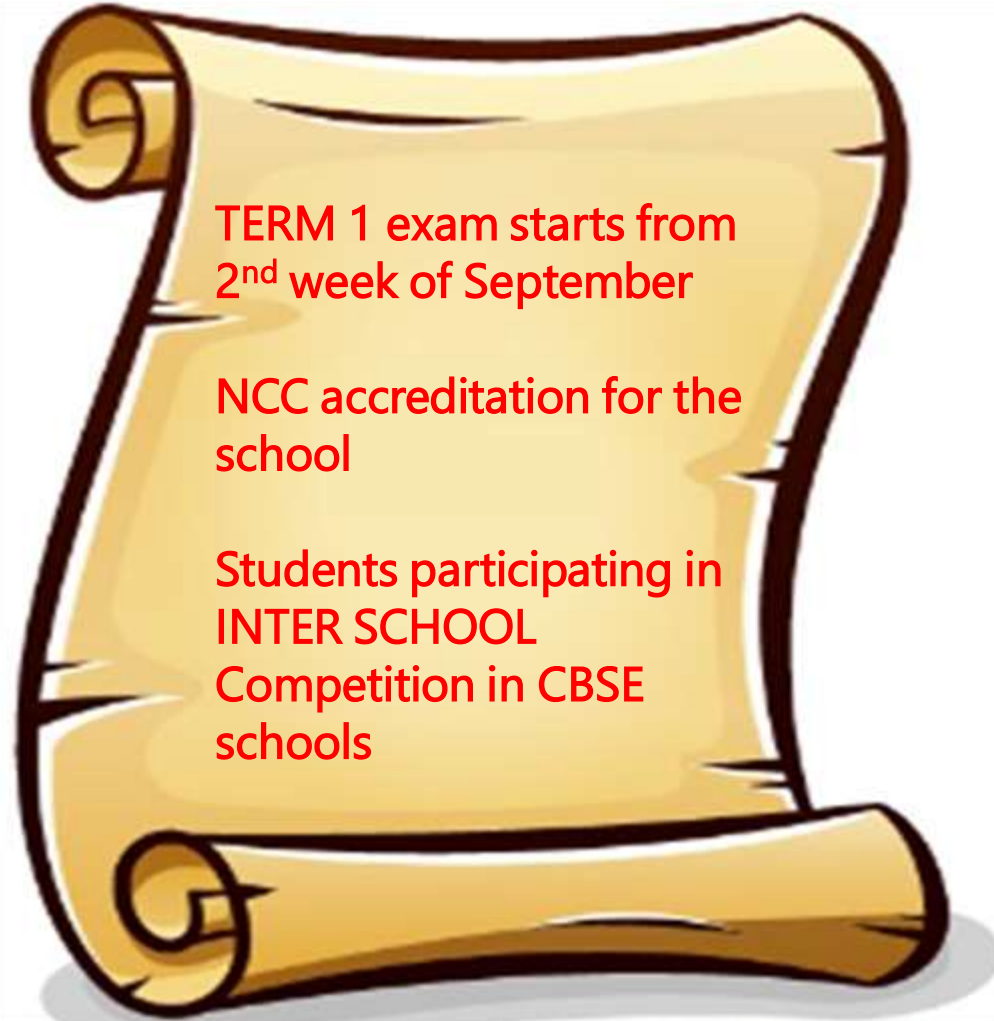
